## Behold Our God > Hebrews 1:1-4

- **1:1** God has spoken in the past. We have a God who speaks, and His words create. This same God spoke His words of life to our forerunners in the faith: words about a Messiah who would rescue His people from their sins.
- **1:2a** God has spoken again now. Jesus Christ is the Word (**John 1:1**), the perfect communication from God. Jesus fully shows us who God is and what God wants because Jesus is, entirely and completely, God.
- **1:2b** Who Jesus is. The author of Hebrews tells us that Jesus, as God's Son, is the heir of all things and is also the One through whom God created the world.
- **1:3a** What Jesus is like. Christ is the radiance of God's glory, the exact representation of God's character, and He has the power of God to uphold the universe.
- **1:3b-4** What Jesus has done. Given this amazing picture of Christ, how wonderful that He is the One who has cleansed all who believe from their sins, and who now rules from on high!

**Context:** The book of Hebrews begins by focusing on our Savior, His uniqueness and unlimited power.

**Argument:** Christ is the saving-one whom the prophets spoke of and pointed to. He is fully, entirely, and uniquely God.

**Gospel:** Jesus' work in His life and through the cross is offered to all who trust Him. This Jesus, our King, has done everything necessary for our eternal salvation and our everlasting joy.
