

Godly Confidence > Psalm 125:1-5

125:1-2 *Surrounded by the Lord.* When we are tempted to doubt the Lord or what He says, the Psalmist reminds us that we have every motivation for trust: those who trust shall not be moved. Those who trust are guarded by the Lord Himself.

125:3 *God's character.* God protects His people both from the challenges of the world around us and from the inclinations of our own sinful desires. His will and ways for us are best.

125:4 *To those who hear.* How do we respond to such a God? For those who hear and believe, we pray and ask for the Lord to do good to us beyond what we deserve.

125:5 *To those who won't hear.* For those who are against the Lord, the call is to beware of the judgment that is coming. Turn now, trust Him, and enjoy His peace forever!

Background: The Psalms of Ascent are thought to have been “the soundtrack” for Jewish pilgrims traveling to Jerusalem for the various festivals and feasts throughout the year.

The Point: God's care for His people knows no limits. He protects us and calls us to have confidence in His character.

Head: Know that God's protection for His people is comprehensive and complete. He will see us safely home.

Heart: Believe that the Lord works for your good, even when you aren't sure how or why. Trust all that He says.

Hands: Live in a way that displays confidence in the Savior.
