## His Word, Our Trust > Psalm 127:1-5

**127:1** Faith-filled work. Hard work and vigilance are only lasting if the Lord is the One whom we are working for, and His ways the only ones that we are working in.

**127:2** *Faith-less worry.* Apart from trusting the Lord, we are tempted to work harder and longer. This derails us from one of the Lord's greatest blessings: genuine rest.

**127:3** *Children are a reward.* Just as we must depend upon the Lord for our work, protection, and rest, so also must we depend upon Him for receiving and raising up children.

**127:4-6** *Children are a blessing.* The blessing of children is seen over the long run: they are the ones who pass the faith on to the next generation.

**Background:** The Psalms of Ascent acted as reminders of faith for God's people throughout the yearly festivals.

**The Point:** We have work, tasks, and responsibilities, but these are only given meaning and worth when done out of faith and trust in the Lord.

**Head:** Know that God's sovereignty is a wonderful blessing for His people.

**Heart:** Believe that the Lord desires to bless His people, and that you can lay hold of His blessing by trusting Christ.

**Hands:** How will you work, rest, and parent in faith, by trusting in the Lord, rather than in your own strength?
