

God Has Spoken > Hebrews 1:1-4

1:1-2a *God has spoken.* God spoke to His people through the prophets in the past; He has now perfectly and completely revealed Himself to us by speaking through the Son.

1:2b-3:a *Who Christ is.* Jesus is fully God and fully man. He perfectly communicates who God is and what God wants to us because Jesus is, Himself, God in the flesh. Jesus has the full authority and power of the Lord.

1:3b-4 *What Christ did.* Christ uses that full authority and power to redeem His people – to rescue all who believe from their sins and rebellion. He now prepares a place for us to be with Him forever in a kingdom where He rules and reigns.

Background: Hebrews is similar to a sermon that has been written down – it has examples and illustrations, quotations from the Old Testament, applications, and challenges. The main theme of the entire book is to see how Jesus being God’s Son gives us hope and challenges us to faithful living.

The Point: Jesus is God – our Savior is God Himself and has both the power and authority to rescue us.

Head: Jesus is God’s Son – He is fully God and fully man. He is our Savior and King.

Heart: Believe that Jesus has done the work to save all who trust in Him; believe in Christ as your Savior and King.

Hands: How will you grow in “listening” to what God has said in this book? Who can be helped by your example?
