God's Call For You > Exodus 4:1-17

4:1-9 What if they won't believe you? Moses asks a question that most of us have struggled with at some point or another: what if the ones he is sent to don't believe the message that he has for them? The Lord graciously gives Moses several signs to prove that he has heard from God.

4:10-17 *What if you don't want to go?* Moses finally admits where his hesitation is coming from: he simply doesn't want God to call him to this kind of life. The Lord graciously helps Moses to prize obedience (through the assistance of Aaron).

Background: God's calling of Moses causes him to ask several questions, each in some way related to his trust (or need for more trust) in what the Lord is doing. Moses' questions aren't so different from our own when it comes to God's call upon each of our lives.

The Point: God provides all that we need to be found faithful in the calling that he has given to us. What we most need is not more skills or confidence, but to trust our Lord.

Head: Know that God provides where he calls – his work for you is do-able if you look to and rely upon him.

Heart: Believe that God is good and that his calling is for your joy as you grow in him. God isn't calling you to make you miserable, but to teach you to enjoy him as you serve him.

Hands: Decide to trust the Lord as you follow the Savior, and ask him to grow in you a trusting and obedient heart.
